Day 1: Wednesday, October 12, 2016 - USA / MUNICH

Pilgrims are welcomed today at an international airport for our departing flight to Munich, Germany via jumbo jet, arriving the next day. Meals and beverages are served on board.

Day 2: Thursday 10/13, MUNICH / ALTÖTTING / SALZBURG


Upon our arrival in Munich, we meet our full-time tour escort and board our motor coach for the journey to **Altötting** in the heart of Bavaria. The city's purpose of pilgrimage stems from one of Germany's most celebrated shrines. We visit the **Chapel of Mary**, which houses a 13th-century statue of the Blessed Virgin to which numerous miraculous cures are credited. While there, we have the opportunity to visit the **Basilica**, the **Panorama of the Crucifixion**, the **Pilgrim Museum**, and **St. Konrad's Monastery**. Then, we continue to **Salzburg**, Austria where we check in at our hotel for a welcome dinner and overnight. [D]

Day 3: Friday 10/14, SALZBURG

Today will be spent in beautiful Salzburg, a compact city that is best explored on foot. Narrow, winding lanes and secluded passageways are evidence of its medieval roots. We hear the bells of the great **Glockenspiel** (clock) Tower, performed to a melody of Mozart's. We enjoy the "Sound of Music" tour. A local guide will board our motor coach and take us through Salzburg beginning at **St. Peter's Churchyard** and **cemetery**, the mighty Romanesque **Cathedral**, the **Fortress Hohensalzburg**, and a view of the **Nonnberg Convent** of Benedictine

nuns. We stop at **Hellbrunn Palace** to enjoy its gardens and hidden trick fountains before continuing to **view some of the city's great houses, mansions, Festival Hall, and the Mirabelle Gardens**. This evening, we enjoy a **Mozart dinner concert**, where you will hear the most popular compositions of Mozart by candlelight and the music will be played by Salzburg artists dressed in historic costumes. The evening will in-

clude a multi-course dinner prepared to the traditional recipes from the 17th and 18th centuries. Overnight in Salzburg. [B,D]

Day 4: Saturday 10/15, SALZBURG / GAMING

Salzburg is so beautiful and has so much to see. Take some **time to explore independently**, soaking in sites that most interest you. A few suggestions include:

- ▶ Getreidegasse is shopper's paradise. While this one mile stretch boasts the most fashionable boutiques, this busy medieval alley of merchandise carries hefty price tags as well.
- ▶ The cloisters and cemetery at the Church of St. Sebastian is amazing. The Mozart family tomb is located here.
- ▶ Browse through the city, snap photos, and soak in the local culture.
- ▶ Those interested in a venturing out a bit may want to travel 20 miles east of Salzburg to Mondsee, home of the church where the wedding scene in "The Sound of Music" was filmed.

After our sightseeing, we proceed southeast to the charming town of **Gaming** to check in at our hotel for dinner and overnight. [B,D]

Day 5: Sunday 10/16, GAMING / Waidhofen / SONNTAGBERG / GAMING

Holy Mass will be celebrated this morning with the students at Franciscan University, Gaming. After Mass, we proceed 20 miles east to **Waidhofen**, near the Ybbs River Valley. Upper and lower Waidhofen city squares are divided by the city's most famous landmark, an onion-domed tower. The tower offers a fantastic vantage point of the city. We stop at the city's 15-century Gothic-style **parish church and the castle**. Just six miles north of Waidhofen is another quaint

town, **Sonntagberg**, where we visit a large and important Catholic pilgrimage site, the **Minor Basilica**, dedicated to the Holy Trinity. After spending time in both Waidhofen and Sonntagberg, we return to Gaming for dinner and overnight. [B,D]

Day 6: Monday 10/17, GAMING / MARIAZELL / GAMING

A daytrip to **Mariazell** is planned for today. Nestled high in Austria's Alpine mountains is the **Basilica and Shrine of Our Lady of Mariazell** (Mother of Mercy). The **Chapel of Miracles** makes this church a popular place of pilgrimage. We spend some time in Mariazell and then return to Gaming, where we will have a **tour of the restored, 14th-century Charterhouse, or Carthusian monastery, the Kartause Maria Thron**. **Free time in Gaming** will allow us to enjoy a walk into the village, a short hike in the beautiful surroundings, or a relaxing and enjoyable taste of the home-brewed **Kartausenbrau** (beer) at the restaurant. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. [B,D]



Day 7: Tuesday 10/18, GAMING / DANUBE RIVER CRUISE / MELK / HEILIGENKREUZ / VIENNA

This morning we proceed to the medieval town of **Durnstein** on the banks of the Danube River. We board a **river vessel** in Durnstein and meander through the picturesque **Wachau Valley to Melk**, where we disembark and proceed to the Benedictine Abbey. We visit the **Abbey** before continuing our journey east to **Heiligenkreuz** to see the oldest continuously operating Cistercian Abbey in the world. The **Heiligenkreuz Abbey** dates back to the 2th century and was built to accommodate the increase in vocations. Today, the abbey is home to over 80 monks who focus on the liturgy and Latin Gregorian chant. Next, we arrive in **Vienna, Austria**, former center of the Hapsburg Empire and now the capital of Austria. We proceed to our hotel in Vienna to check in for dinner and overnight. [B,D]

Day 8: Wednesday 10/19, VIENNA

Our morning in Vienna begins with Viennese pastries and coffee. Then, we board our motor coach for a **tour of the city**, including the **gardens of Belvedere Palace**, the **State Opera**, and the ultra-modern **United Nations City** on the banks of the Danube River. Then, we visit **Hofburg**, formerly the seat of Austrian power for over six centuries. While at Hofburg, we see the **Imperial Treasury (Schatzkammer)** where priceless secular and ecclesiastical collections are displayed. We drive along the famous Ring Road and stop in at **St. Stephen's Cathedral**. This afternoon, we have **free time** to explore on our own. This evening, the group will gather for a **farewell dinner at a deluxe restaurant**. Overnight in Vienna. [B,D]


Day 9: Thursday 10/20, VIENNA

TERMS AND CONDITIONS / TOUR CONTRACT

TOUR PRICE: Based on tariffs and currency exchange rates in effect on 12/1/2015 and subject to change without notice should there be a revision in rates prior to departure of tour. The tour price is based on a minimum of 36 passengers. Should there be fewer, there could be a surcharge.

ACCOMMODATIONS: In first class hotels or better, based on double or triple occupancy with private facilities. Single-room supplement is \$59 per night and based on availability. Requests for a roommate are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis and are not guaranteed. The single-room supplement will be assessed if a roommate is not available when the group is finalized.

MEALS: Eight full hot breakfasts and seven dinners throughout the basic tour (continental breakfasts in hotels only where full breakfasts are not available). Extra charge for beverage not included in the menu of the day.

TIPS AND TAXES: Those normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as "service" are included. **Airport fees, departure taxes, and fuel surcharges are estimated on the original invoice and adjusted at the time of ticketing.**

SIGHTSEEING: By modern motorcoach, including services of English-speaking guides and entrance fees to places included in the itinerary. Masses at churches indicated are subject to availability.

NOT INCLUDED: 1: Airport fees, departure taxes and fuel surcharges (est. - \$719); 2: tips to guides and drivers, meal servers and luggage handlers (\$120.25); and 3: optional travel insurance. **An amount to cover these items will be added to your original invoice.** Also not included: domestic baggage fees, passport and visa fees, laundry, wines, liquors, meals not included in the itinerary, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned and items of a personal nature. Note: Due to limited storage space on motor coaches, Pentecost Tours entitles each passenger to one checked bag and one carry-on bag that meets airline "size/weight" allowances. Domestic baggage fees, overweight baggage charges, and fees for additional bags fall under the responsibility of the passenger. Be aware, while you may agree to pay fees for additional luggage, there may not be room on the motor coach.

ASSISTANCE: Pilgrims who require personal assistance must be accompanied by a paying passenger who will provide that assistance.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure reservations, which sum will be applied to the price of the tour, with the **balance to be paid in full no later than 7/12/2016.** Payment of remaining balance received after 7/12/2016 will incur a \$50 penalty. Reservations made within 92 days of departure may be subject to a late charge. In the event of cancellation, refund will be made up to 6/14/2016 with a \$100 administrative fee plus any airline cancellation penalties. From 6/14/2016 to 7/12/2016 the cancellation penalty is \$500 plus any airline cancellation penalties. If cancellation is received after 7/12/2016, refund will be subject to a minimum 40% cancellation fee plus any airline cancellation penalties, or an amount equal to expenses to the tour operator, whichever is greater. There will be no refund for cancellations within 33 days of departure. Cancellation must be in writing and the effective date will be the date that Pentecost Tours, Inc. receives it. In the event 15 passengers do not book the tour within 120 days of departure, the agent reserves the right to cancel the tour. If the entire tour is cancelled by Pentecost Tours, Inc., you are entitled to a full refund.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip JFK/Munich and Vienna/JFK on economy class jet via Delta or any other IATA member. Based on 6-day minimum/21-day maximum advanced purchase fare, subject to participation of ten persons on entire flight itinerary. If cancellation is effected by passenger after 7/12/2016, or after air tickets are written,

whichever comes first, 100% of airfare will be forfeited by passenger in addition to the penalties mentioned above. All airfares are subject to government approval and change without notice.

INSURANCE: Insurance is NOT included in the tour price. Because of the cost of medical care outside the United States, the fact that Medicare does not provide coverage outside the United States, the possibility that your own insurance provider may not cover you outside the United States, and due to the potentially high cost of escorted air evacuation, travel insurance is strongly recommended. Consequently, for the protection of our clients, you will be mailed a travel insurance brochure/policy along with an insurance waiver form in the event you choose to decline coverage. The effective date of coverage will be the date that the insurance premium is paid and not the date of the initial deposit.

RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY: Land arrangements including surface transportation: Pentecost Tours, Inc., and the participating Tour Operators operate the land tours offered under this program only as agents of the railroads, car rental contractors, steamship lines, hotels, bus operators, sightseeing contractors and others that provide the actual land arrangements and are not liable for any act, omission, delay, injury, loss, damage or nonperformance occurring in connection with these land arrangements. Delta and other IATA carriers, steamship lines and other transportation companies whose services are featured in these tours are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board their conveyance. The passage contract in use by these companies when issued shall constitute the sole contract between the companies and the purchaser of these tours and/or passage.

MISCELLANEOUS FEES: All changes must be in writing and may incur a per-person charge for each revision. Deposits received within 92 days of departure may incur a late registration fee.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary because of emergencies or extenuating circumstances beyond our control.

ERRORS: The Pentecost Tours staff does its best to provide you with accurate billing, brochures, etc. However, in the event of computer error, verbal or written human errors, we reserve the right to invoice, re-invoice, or forward corrected materials.
